

**Permanent Solution to end
De-forestation ,
save every sentient being ,
Promote Environmental
Conservation across Bharat**

According to the India State of Forest Report 2021, the forest cover is currently at 21.67% of the total geographical area. India formulated its first National Forest Policy in 1952, aiming to bring 33% of the land under forest cover to maintain ecological stability.

In 2001, the India State of Forest Report (ISFRs) made some big changes to the way they classified and counted pixels in a satellite image as forest. They began using finer-scaled satellite imagery and an entirely digital workflow to analyse them. In addition, the ISFRs also changed their definition of a forest. They now explicitly included any lands of at least one hectare area and with 10% or more tree cover, regardless of the tree species on the land, or the purpose for which it was

grown, or its ownership, as forest. So, all of a sudden, tea estates, coconut plantations, mango orchards, homestead gardens of suburban housing developments, and even tree-lined avenues in densely built-up cities were being classified as 'forest'. In one stroke, just between the 1999 and the 2001, this redefinition helped raise India's forest cover by over 38,000 sq.km., the size of Kerala. So can a true environmentalist rely on this existing figures ?

Deforestation is only & only because of the two reasons - first unaccountability of elected representatives / political leaders, Judges bureaucrats, government officers, towards the citizens & second the land scam - Absence of laws which demote land hoarding in urban and semi-urban areas.

Addressing this 2 issues –

Laws govern any country / society, and citizens should promote laws that empower them, rather than focusing

solely on “good” leaders or “good” political parties. A “good” leader and a “good” party are a form of political ignorance created by the paid media.

“ Paryavaran Bachao VoteVapsi Passbook Group ” has drafted & campaigning to bring laws which can address the above 2 issues, which are the root cause of Environmental degradation not only in Bharat but across the globe -

1) Un-accountability of elected representatives / political leaders,

Judges bureaucrats, government officers, towards the citizens & Environment Minister towards the environment -

(ii) Making the Authority officially incharge for Environmental conservation ie. *Environment Minister* accountable towards the common citizens –

**Proposed VoteVapsi Environment
Minister or Right to Recall**

Environment Minister - Common citizens will have the power to replace the State & the central Environment Minister if they are found corrupt, incompetent, negligent towards environmental conservation, before their term by proving majority without a need to complaint their higher authority.

- The only duty of the Environment minister, the duty for which he is paid for by the tax payers ie. us common citizens hard earned money is to conserve environment and nothing

else. Understand this with an elaborative example –

Say you own a Departmental store with 20 employees & suddenly Govt makes 2 new rules

- you can NOT expel managers till they are 65 years and can't expel any workers for next 5 years

- you must give advance pay-checks of next 5 years to 35 years today itself

- even if you suspect that an employee is stealing your goods, you can't stop him from coming to your

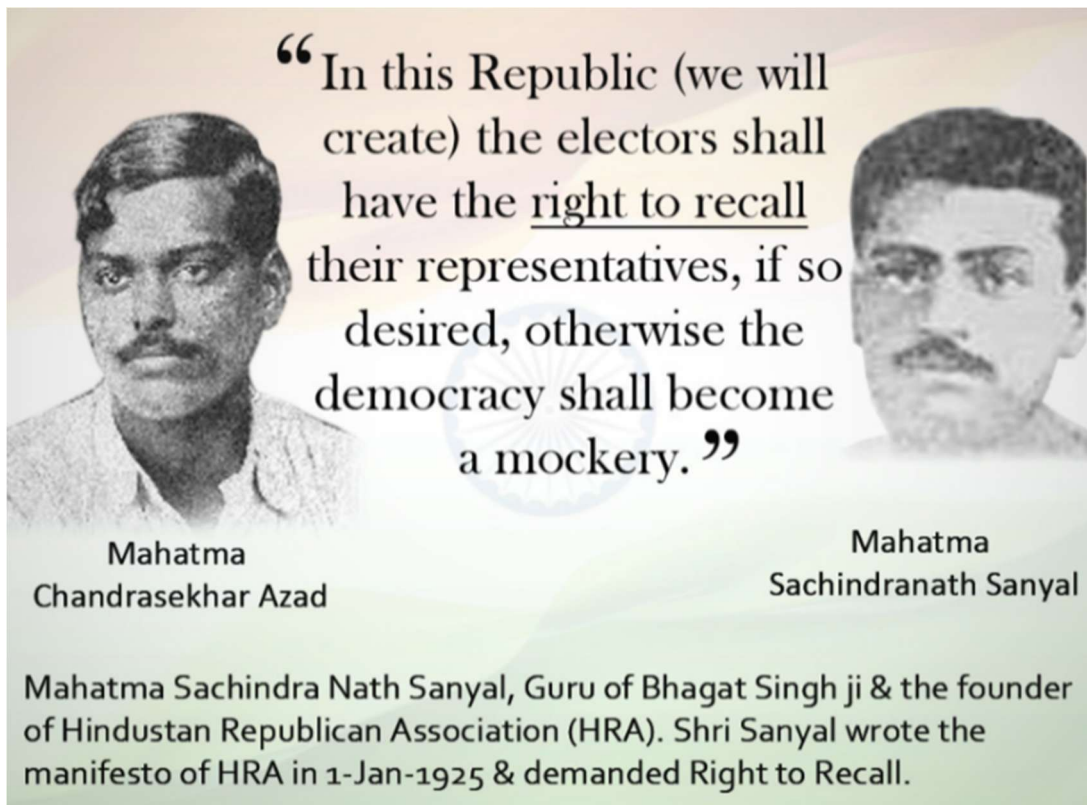
store and cannot replace him till a judge orders him not to come and allows you to replace him

- Question: Then in 3 months, will the level of indiscipline in 1000 employees increase or decrease?

Off coarse, its plain vanilla common sense, its bound to decrease !!!

IOW, if we, the commons of India, cannot expel & replace judges, MPs, Ministers, IAS, etc, they will all become undisciplined, corrupt, nepotic, etc. That's why Mahatma Chandrashekhar Azad / Mahatma

Sachindranath Sanyal (guru of Mahatma Bhagat Singh) said in 1925 that " ***Elections without recall will be a mockery*** " ,



Satyarth Prakash (see first page of chap-61 says that "***Raajaa must be***

Prajaadheen or else he will rob citizens".)There are many environmentalist across the country, dedicately working for this cause selflessly without any government support in many cases. If Right to Recall Environment Minister law was in place , Citizens would have made any such true environmentalist the Environment Minister of the country or their state. Just imagine the positive change this law would have made for the country , environment overall.

**(iii) Atrocities on genuine activists
/ Environmentalists / fake cases
against them -**

As you may have seen number of fake cases against local Adivasis, Activist , Environmentalist who were protesting against deforestation & the court cases going on and on to cause harassment.

The root cause to this problem is the Corruption in Police & Judiciary & permanent solution is the following –

(1) **Judiciary** –

➤ There are ~ 10 crore pending cases in India & we only have ~23,000 Judges , we need at least 2 lakh Judges to resolve the pending cases.

➤ Judges once appointed and that too via interviews and not through written exams , hence are not accountable towards the citizens & keep on giving dates after dates. This is because they know that citizens don't have the power to expel & replace them(even appoint/elect

them). **Clause 37.6 & 37.7 of #Proposed_Jury_Court Law empowers citizens to replace the Judge by proving majority without conflicting any articles of our Constitution.**

➤ Citizens should deliver justice & not only the Judge ie. Jury Court system. The Jury (Jury are 15 to 1500 randomly selected citizens from the voter list between 25 to 55 years of age) would have the legal right to determine the punishment after hearing the same trial daily with the

judge until it's resolved. Also, 75% Jury can conduct a public Narco test of the offender to decide whether the accused is honest or lying & can determine the death penalty as well. The Jury citizen will also have the right to impose monetary punishment on the criminals and to confiscate the property. This is not a coincidence that countries which have Jury system have far less corruption in their government & oppression towards citizens as compared to the countries with Judge system.

Difference between Judge system Vs Jury system

1. Speed of Decisions

Most of the cases go to only one person. A Judge gives judgment in 5,000 to 20,000 cases during his tenure. Hence cases remain pending for years

Because there is a separate Jury for each case, the verdict comes within a week or 2. With quick verdicts, opportunities for intimidation and buying/bribing of witnesses are

reduced.

2. Continuity of alliance

Usually a Judge stays in a court for 3-4 years. Due to sufficient time, it becomes easy for criminals and lawyers to form a nexus with the judge. 3. Protection from organized crime:

If 1000 cases are registered against a gang and gang leader in 4-5 years, then in the Judge system all these cases will go to 5-10 judges. 4. Possibility of succumbing under pressure:

The role of senior judges is decisive in the promotion, transfer, removal etc. of junior judges. Therefore, in most of the cases, influential accused succeed in influencing the junior judges.

The citizens who appear on the Jury are not in anyone's employ. They come to the Jury only to hear a case for sometime and give a verdict. Therefore, pressure from any officer, etc. does not work on them.

5. Opportunities to take bribe:

It is an open matter that a particular judge has given a specific decision. Because of this, the judge has to give a verdict in favor of the person who has given the bribe. Otherwise, the mediating lawyer will not come forward with a bribe offer for him next time. Apart from

In the Jury system, each Juror gives his/her verdict in the form of Yes/No in a sealed envelope. So even if the accused influences any 5 out of 15 jurors through pressure/incitement in some way or the other, they can give a verdict against him. Because the

this, when pressure comes, they have to change their decisions even if they do not want to.	decision of the Jury member cannot be known.

(2) **Police Department** -
[#Right_To_Recall_District_Police_Chief](#) - Municipal Commissioner of Police / SP of a district is directly appointed by the Home Minister / Chief Minister, hence there is no accountability of S.P's towards the citizens as his job is in the hands of the Home Minister & Chief Ministers

and not the citizens, hence he follows HM's & CM's order and not of the citizen's if he want to continue his job.

- As contrast, with the US & other developed countries were the district Police Chief are not only elected but also expelled & replaced by the citizens if they are found corrupt or exploitative. Clause 29.1, 32.1 & 33.1 of Proposed Jury Court law has procedures to expel & replace district Police Chief.

-Hence, you will find inhumane beatings and exploitation, use of

brute force against the protestors, environmentalists, to clear the forests.

- By this proposed Jury Court law, justice will be delivered from the court within 7 days to 1 month, and there will be almost cleansing of crimes & Anti social elements from the society.

- There are many honest, selfless, capable, and efficient officers in the police department, judiciary, and other government sectors. However, since their positions are controlled by the Chief Minister, Home Minister,



senior officials, or political leaders, they are often forced to work within restrictive boundaries. If an officer attempts to go beyond these limits and act independently, they may be transferred to a remote area, or worse, face serious harm, even potentially being murdered. The absence of laws such as the Right to Recall for District Police Chiefs and Judges, as well as a Referendum or Jury Court system, stifles the ability of these honest, selfless officers to fulfill their duties to the best of their ability,

ultimately hindering their efforts to pursue justice and righteousness.

➤ **Why am I placing such great importance on the issue of corruption within the Police and the Judiciary in an article aimed at saving environment ?** - It's

because the proper and fair functioning of these institutions is fundamental for the efficient operation of all **government departments in a country including environmental, Pollution control once. When any person, whether from the government or not, breaks the law, it is the police's responsibility to**

apprehend the accused and collect evidence. Subsequently, the judge decides whether to detain or release the accused. Fixing these 2 departments is essential because when they work effectively, the law and order of the entire country can significantly improve.

➤ There are countless examples of factories discharging untreated wastewater into natural water bodies, polluting them and severely harming marine life. How is this possible? It's because many factory owners

manipulate pollution control board officials, judges, and local police to continue their illegal activities.

➤ It's deeply ironic that in a country like , where rivers are revered as mothers, they are polluted with such impunity. Meanwhile, in many Western nations—where rivers are seen as just rivers, where there are more factories than India, then too — water bodies are often kept clean and well-maintained.

➤ This stark contrast exists primarily because of Citizen-empowering laws

in those countries that hold politicians, judges, and government officials accountable to the public.

➤ **The Impact of the Absence of Citizen-Empowering Laws :**

- One of the most horrific examples is the Bhopal Gas Tragedy. It was not only an environmental disaster but also a massive human tragedy—over 22,000 people and countless animals lost their lives. Yet, shockingly, no one was held truly accountable & punished.

As it is well known that the Biggest contributor of Green house gases & the most resource intensive industry being the Meat industry.

Understand this with recent Gachibowli deforestation example-

– Number of mammal animals larger than rabbits per acre in forest (including dogs, wolves, foxes, deer's, Neelgaay, wild cows, wild buffalo, lion, tiger, all) = at most 2 animal per

acre & density in small forests (smaller than 1000 acres) is less.

So the maximum number of mammal animals that died when the Gachibowli Hyderabad forest of 400 acres was cut = 800 at most or maybe 400.

- Number of mammal animals slaughtered per day = ~ 6 lakhs.

YES, over 6 lakhs and many more if illegal cow slaughter is added.

If the government subsidies to animal slaughter end, then the Number of

mammal animals slaughtered will reduce by over 50% .So government subsidies to meat are the biggest mammal animal killer.

It is extremely sad and shameful that this is the reality in a land as sacred as the birthplace of great spiritual leaders like Gautam Buddha, Mahavira, Adi Shankaracharya, Guru Nanak, Sant Tukaram, and Ramdas Swamiji, who all preached the sanctity of life and respect for all living beings.

“ If an environmentalist or nature lover chooses to dedicate their life to one of the five demands or steps mentioned above, their efforts may or may not lead to success. Even if they do succeed in fulfilling that particular demand, it raises a crucial question : how will the other equally important demands be addressed ? Furthermore, what if the ruling class (government / Elites) later decides to reverse or cancel the progress made on that specific issue ?

However, if all true environmentalists, nature lovers, and animal rights advocates unite to launch a mass movement demanding citizen-empowering & land de-hoarding law such as the TCP / Referendum, the VoteVapsi Passbook, the Jury Court system, Empty Land tax & Sarkari Jameen Kiraya Batwara law—then all the key steps required to save the environment can be fulfilled collectively. More importantly, these reforms (proposed laws) would ensure that such steps are protected

and sustained, as the ruling class would become accountable to the people through these proposed mechanisms.”

➤ With the implementation of this law in the Gazette land(land & Construction Built up area) above a certain limit will be taxable at the rate

of 1% of market price per annum. This law does not tax the land, but brings un-usable, hoarded, non-working land under the tax purview. The landowners owning such excess land have to file an ELT return annually.

➤ In the city like Mumbai were nearly 80% of the people live in either slums, chawls or roadside, almost 20% habitable of Mumbai is owned by only 9 trusts / families. (excluding Borivali National Park, mangroves,

government land, i.e. pure 20% habitable land). So if you calculate this mathematically, no one has so much wealth to pay such a humongous amount of tax, so the result will be, the elites / ruling class who have hoarded miles of unused , empty land/properties will have to either sell it or rent it, this way there will be surplus land available for productive activities/ residence, industries, etc. the land prices will go down thus ending horizontal expansion of cities & hence

permanently ending the artificial scarcity of land created by elites/ruling class in urban and semi-urban areas.

(ii) For Government Plots – Sarkari Jameen Kiraya Batwara Law

➤ The purpose of this law is to bring all those government-owned plots in the market which the government and the public are not using. all such plots owned by the Central and State Governments, which are lying vacant today, will be given on lease for a

period of 15 to 25 years. The amount collected from the rent received from this land will be divided equally among all the iya.

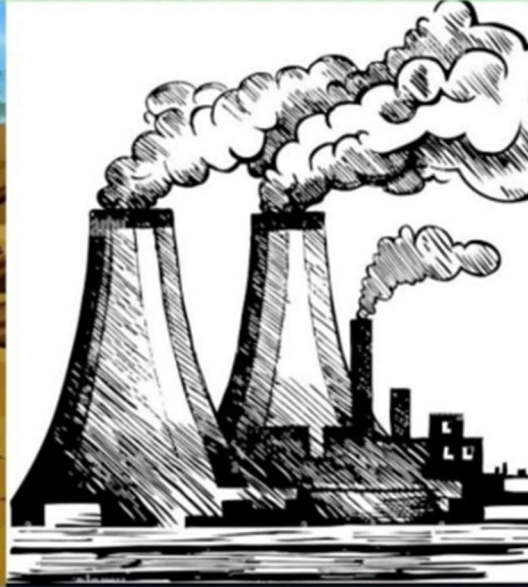

If you call yourself an environmentalist but do nothing to push for these necessary laws, then indirectly, you're contributing to the destruction of forests / environment / every sentient being. You're essentially wasting time, playing into the hands of elites who want us to engage in meaningless activities. These tactics—like rallies, protests, dharna pradarshan and social media rants (without demand of citizen-empowering laws) —may seem like activism, but they don't address the

root causes of the problems after a certain point.

Have these conventional tactics, such as dharnas, protests, and social media outbursts(without demand of citizen-empowering laws) , ever stopped the government from destroying another forests? Engaging in activities without advocating for citizen-empowering laws amounts to nothing more than beating around the bush.

The same scenes repeat with no tangible difference. Over the years,

we've witnessed numerous deforestation drives in ecologically sensitive and biodiversity-rich areas: the Aarey Forest in Mumbai (2019 & 2022), the Aravalis range from Rajasthan to Delhi , the Dantewada Forest in Chhattisgarh (2012-2022), Buxwaha in Madhya Pradesh (2021-2022), and unplanned commercial activities in eco-sensitive regions like Ladakh, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, and the Himalayan region. The ruling class and paid media occasionally offer token successes to

make a hero out of someone, creating a fake opposition to pacify the movement. This tactic diverts attention from the core issue, leading activists away from genuine reform efforts. Rather than pursuing lasting legal changes, we get stuck in endless cycles of rallies and slogans—merely a distraction.

Despite regular protests against deforestation and for environmental conservation, nothing changes. The government continues to exercise pure dictatorship, suppressing the

voices of ordinary citizens, harassing true environmentalists, and filing fake cases against them. The result? Real activism for bringing citizen-empowering laws that can achieve environmental conservation is sidelined, and the destruction continues.

The Paryavaran Bachao VoteVapsi Jury movement has designed a Draft lead decentralized mass movement (आंदोलन) that enables every citizen—regardless of how busy they are, whether an office worker, businessperson, student, or anyone

else—to actively participate without impacting their personal or professional lives, taking meaningful steps toward implementing laws that protect both people and nature. What's remarkable is that this participation requires no permission from the police or any government department. ***By investing just 5 minutes and 50 paisa per month, anyone can join and contribute to this impactful movement.***

By sending a written open order — preferably via postcard demanding

these proposed laws — to the Prime Minister and Chief Minister once a month on a fixed date, time, and at a designated place (ideally on the 5th of every month, which is observed as *Citizens' Duty Day*, or any other convenient day).

After sending, a photo of this open order postcard can be uploaded to various social media groups and personal accounts to spread awareness and ensure that this solution-oriented, law-based movement reaches the masses. A

Xerox copy of each open order should also be maintained in our personal *Citizens' Duty Register*.

This format of *Andolan* (movement) addresses several problems often found in traditional protest movements namely :

1. Typically, movements are led by a single figure — a leader, NGO, political party, social worker, or lawyer — often carry multiple demands (e.g., 20 different issues). The leader decides the date, time, and location of the protests.

- If the ruling class (e.g., the Chief Minister or Prime Minister) is able to compromise this leader (through bribery, coercion, or even elimination), they may concede to only a few minor demands and sabotage the rest of the movement.
- As a result, true activists and sincere citizens feel betrayed, lose trust in political or social causes, and the movement eventually collapses.
- The **Open Order Method** via postcard avoids this pitfall by decentralizing leadership. In this

model, *the written draft laws themselves are the leaders* — not any individual. Every participant is simply an initiator. No one holds the authority to alter the proposed drafts, which are designed to solve systemic problems in society.

- Moreover, the time, date, and place are fixed : for example, the 5th of every month at 5 p.m. at your local main post office. Informed citizens and activists gather there regularly to send these written demands in the form of proposed laws. As the

number of participants increases, pressure mounts on the ruling class (esp. Chief Minister and Prime Minister) to implement these citizen-empowering laws. With more citizens sending open demands for these laws, it becomes evident that public **common knowledge** of these solution-oriented laws is growing. The ruling class then realizes that failing to implement these laws could damage their public image and potentially cost them the next election.

- This consistent, decentralized method will also attract attention from politically active individuals particularly those from mainstream parties who feel sidelined, or independent candidates without a strong agenda. Observing a genuine, leaderless movement that gains traction month after month, some may adopt these citizen-empowering laws as the core of their political campaigns. They'll realize that this cause already has grassroots

support, which can translate into votes.

This is how the movement creates **political demand** — the one thing the ruling class fears the most in the countries having Voting System — thereby applying further pressure on the system to introduce meaningful legal reforms.

2. **Dilution of a Demand Reaching the Apex Authorities/Masses:**

- Any conventional movement, protest, or demonstration relies

heavily on paid media (acting as a middle men - such as media outlets, YouTubers, print media like newspapers, radio, etc., which are now owned by foreign entities) to spread its message to the masses and, ultimately, to the apex authorities. This reliance on paid media gives them the power to selectively present or twist the demands in ways that align with the interests of their masters i.e. foreign powers. As a result, the movement becomes weakened, as the public

receives only partial or biased information, discouraging widespread support.

- A more effective approach to breaking this dependency is this decentralized Draft Lead mass movement that directly reaches the apex authorities (i.e., the Prime Minister and Chief Minister) & citizens through open orders of proposed law drafts via postcards. This method ensures that the demands, having their detailed legal procedure draft, are conveyed directly to the decision-

makers & the citizens, bypassing the influence & need of paid media. An essential step in this process is keeping a record of these submissions in a Citizens' Duty Register, such as a photocopy of each postcard sent.

- This record serves to build pressure against the authorities, as activists or concerned citizens can publicly show their submissions and demonstrate how the Prime Minister or Chief Minister has failed to address the issue.

3. **Why Postcard is preferred over inland letter & tweet** ? One of the primary goals of designing this Open-order format via a postcard— a form of Decentralized Draft lead Mass movement—is to establish a network of real activists and concerned citizens across the country & their physical ground gathering to ensure that vital solution-oriented information reaches them without the need for paid media (middle-men).

- This can be achieved since Citizen-empowering law drafts serve

as the true leaders of this movement, rather than any single individual having all the powers of the movement dictating the time or place of the protest (Andolan).

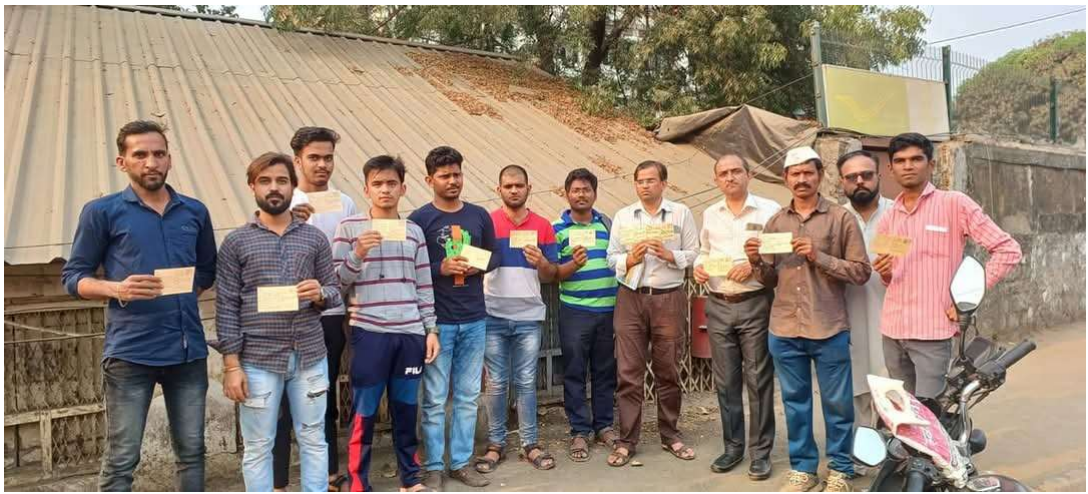
- As the number of people participating increases month after month, the growing volume of people/crowd outside the post office will put pressure on authorities to publish these laws.

- If they fail to do so, they risk exposure, and if their political contender adopts our proposed laws

in their election agenda, it could pose a significant threat to the current authorities in the upcoming elections.

Since a postcard is an open letter format —meaning all postal staff from the sender's location to the destination can read its contents—the sender's demands, written boldly (such as say “Jury Court” - name of a citizen-empowering law), become visible to many. When the same word or demand appears every month, from multiple citizens across different

post offices across the country, it naturally piques curiosity. This repetition further helps create common knowledge about these proposed citizen-empowering laws. In turn, further breaking through the narrative controlled by paid media, which often aims to keep the public unaware of real solutions and the empowerment of the masses.

(2) **Fighting elections for this Cause** - Fighting elections to

implement citizen-empowering laws that can help save the environment is one of the greatest contributions one can make to nature, the country, or society. During elections, the public becomes more politically aware, and what might take 365 days of campaigning can often be achieved more effectively by contesting elections.

Understand this from a recent example : 2020-21 Farmers Protest in Punjab / Haryana against 3 Farm laws –

September 2020	3 Farm laws passed
September - October 2020	Farmers agitation starts in Punjab, Haryana & parts of UP
November 2021	Narendra Modi cancels 3 farm law on the wake of UP, Punjab Vidhan Sabha elections to be held in Q1-2022 & Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh elections later

As you can see, the chronology speaks for itself. The government remained unmoved despite over 500 farmer unions and other peasant organizations protesting for more

than a year. During this time, over 750 farmers lost their lives, enduring harsh conditions—both in the cold and heat—at the outskirts of Delhi, all in opposition to the 3 farm laws.

However, as soon as the 2022 Vidhan Sabha elections were announced, Gurnam Singh Charuni, a prominent farmer leader, declared his intention to form a political party solely focused on farmers' issues and to contest elections centered around these farm laws.

In response, Prime Minister Narendra Modi revoked all three farm laws, likely spurred by the fear that a genuine political opposition might arise, especially with elections on the horizon.

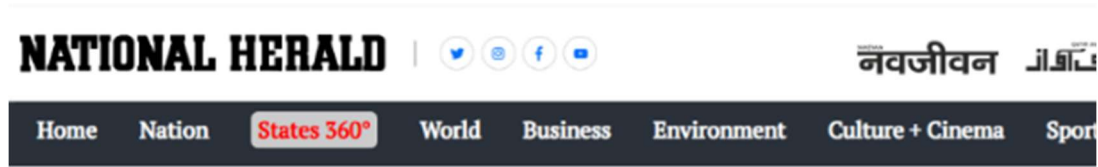
Additionally, various Lockdown & forced vaccination-related restrictions were eased in the lead-up to the elections, reflecting the government's political calculations.

These examples illustrate how making an issue central to electoral

campaigns can pressure the government to act.

(3) The Right to Recall Party, part of the “Paryavaran Bachao VoteVapsi Passbook Jury Movement” , has been contesting elections since 2019 (and independently since 2009) to bring these empowering laws into effect. Currently, they have fielded 25 candidates in the Delhi Vidhan Sabha Elections 2025, around 20 candidates in the Maharashtra Vidhan Sabha Elections 2024, and approximately 40

candidates in the Lok Sabha Elections 2024.

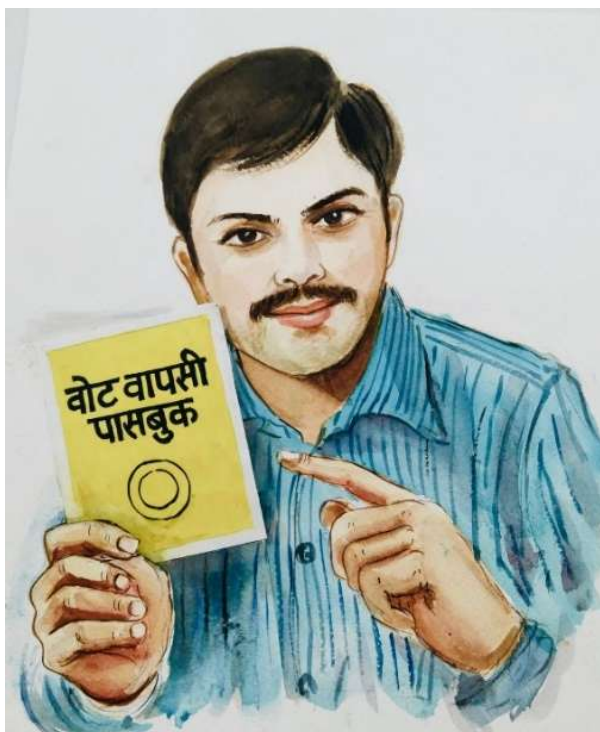
